FIRST COUNT

1. On or about the 31st day of March, 2000, the plaintiff, Susan Smith, was the owner and operator of a motor vehicle travelling on the Manhattan Bridge in New York City, New York.

2. At the time and place aforesaid, the plaintiff was struck in the rear by a vehicle which left the scene of the accident.

3. It is the plaintiff's contention that the circumstances of the loss set forth above create an uninsured motorist claim against Acme Insurance Company.

4. Demand for arbitration was timely made upon Acme Insurance Company and arbitrators have been named by plaintiff and Acme Insurance Company. However, those two arbitrators have been unable to agree upon the appointment of a third arbitrator as provided for under the terms of the policy between plaintiff and Acme. The policy provides for court appointment of the third arbitrator if such an impasse occurs.

WHEREFORE, the plaintiff respectfully requests that the court appoint the third arbitrator provided for under the terms of the policy and schedule a hearing date in the near future.
