FIRST COUNT

1. On or about the 31st day of March, 2000, the plaintiff, Susan Smith, was the owner and operator of a motor vehicle travelling on the Manhattan Bridge in New York City, New York.

2. At the time and place aforesaid, the plaintiff was struck in the rear by a vehicle which left the scene of the accident.

3. It is the plaintiff's contention that the circumstances of the loss set forth above create an uninsured motorist claim against Acme Insurance Company.

4. Demand for arbitration has been made upon Acme Insurance Company to appoint an arbitrator in order to commence UM proceedings. The time period for Acme to act in this regard, as defined in the policy, has now expired;

WHEREFORE, the plaintiff demands (1) that the defendant be required to appoint an arbitrator and schedule a hearing date in the near future; and (2) counsel fees and costs in connection with this application.
