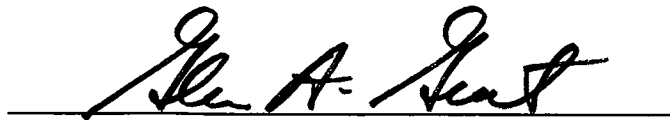


NOTICE TO THE BAR

ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS TO COURT RULES 1:38-3 AND 1:38-5

Published with this notice are the following amendments to Rule 1:38 ("Public Access to Court Records and Administrative Records") as adopted by the Supreme Court; these amendments become effective May 1, 2019:

- Amendments to **Rule 1:38-3** ("Court Records Excluded from Public Access") so as to exclude from public access two new confidential forms required for Civil adult name change applications (Certification of Confidential Information for Name Change; Final Judgment Addendum); adopted by order dated April 23, 2019; and
- Amendments to **Rule 1:38-5** ("Administrative Records Excluded from Public Access") so as to clarify the exclusion of oaths of judges, judicial officials, and Judiciary personnel from public access, and to provide that in response to a request (including a request for a judicial oath of office) the record custodian will provide the full name, title, and oath date of the individual; adopted by separate order dated April 23, 2019.
