Notice of Parental Rights in Adoption Proceeding (Non-Agency Placement)

Right to Counsel
You have the right to be represented by an attorney.
If you can afford an attorney but do not know one, you may call the Bar Association Lawyer Referral Service of the county where the case will be heard at

If you cannot afford an attorney and qualify due to your income, the court will appoint an attorney to represent you in the adoption proceeding.
How to Apply for a Court-Appointed Attorney
To file for a court appointed attorney do the following:
1. Check this box: \Box I want to apply for a court-appointed attorney.
2. Complete the attached <i>Application for Assignment of Counsel</i> form.
3. File this form with the County Surrogate located at
within 20 days of receiving this notice if you live in New Jersey, or within 35 days of receiving this notice if you live outside of New Jersey.
The court will notify you about your application for a court-appointed attorney.
