**WHEREAS**, on December 16, 2019, the Court entered Standing Order 19-7 to enact safety and security procedures including screening protocols for entry into all United States Courthouses and Federal Court facilities in the District of New Jersey (“District of New Jersey buildings/facilities”); and

**WHEREAS**, on October 12, 2023, the Court entered Standing Order 2023-03, which amended and supplemented Standing Order 19-7, to reflect the Board of Judges’ adoption of enhanced screening protocols for entry into same District of New Jersey buildings/facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, upon reevaluating the safety and security needs of this District, specifically, as to the District of New Jersey buildings/facilities, and for spatial concerns, the Court deems it necessary and appropriate to further enhance and update screening protocols for entry; accordingly


**IT IS ORDERED**, effective immediately, that no person (except resident federal employees, tenant employees, and visiting employees of the U.S. Courts, including but not limited to the District of New Jersey), will be permitted to have proximity access cards, swipe cards, and/or keys for entry into District of New Jersey buildings/facilities; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the press room on the third floor of the Martin Luther King Building & U.S. Courthouse, 50 Walnut Street, Newark, New Jersey 07102, shall be returned to the Court for its official judiciary business; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this Standing Order supersedes, nullifies, and voids all prior Orders to the contrary, including but not limited to all 2011 orders granting the media exceptional access to District of New Jersey buildings/facilities; and it is further

**ORDERED** that all provisions of Standing Order 19-7 and Standing Order 2023-03 that are not within the scope of this Standing Order remain in full force and effect; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this Standing Order is effective immediately, May 21, 2025.
