The Chief Justice has asked that I call to your attention the motion order which requires that motions in all trial courts shall be heard on Fridays, except that motions in the Law Division of the Superior Court shall be heard on designated days, generally on every other Friday.

No Chancery Division judge should schedule motions for a day other than Friday without first receiving the approval of the Assignment Judge.

The only change that has been made is the deletion of the reference to county courts.
