

Court Reporters C Transcripts

Directive #16-69

December 22, 1969

Issued by:

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- A. The Supreme Court has asked that we request all court reporters to include the following in the transcripts of all criminal proceedings:
1. The time when the case goes to the jury and the jury departs from the courtroom to consider the case.
 2. The time if and when the jury should return to the courtroom with questions to be answered by the court.
 3. The time when the jury returns with its verdict.

EDITOR-S NOTE

The second paragraph of this directive, dealing with the reporters obligation to notify all other parties to a case of a transcript request, has been deleted because the provision doesn't conform to practice.
