New Plea Form: Additional Questions for Certain Drug and Weapons Offenses Committed on or After June 24, 1998

As recently amended, *N.J.S.A.* 2C:39-4.1 provides that the sentence for a weapons conviction is to be served consecutively to that imposed for a conviction of certain CDS offenses. The Supreme Court, at its Administrative Conference on March 1, 1999, approved the Criminal Practice Committee=s recommendation to promulgate a new plea form, Additional Questions for Certain Drug and Weapons Offenses Committed on or after June 24, 1998. ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS FOR CERTAIN DRUG AND WEAPONS OFFENSES COMMITTED ON OR AFTER JUNE 24, 1998

The following questions need to be answered if you are pleading guilty to certain drug offenses and also are pleading guilty to possession of a firearm or other weapon while committing, attempting to commit or conspiring to commit any of the following offenses. If a firearm was possessed, answer questions 1 a, b and c. If a firearm was not possessed, mark question 1a not applicable [NA] and answer questions 1b and c.
