In accordance with the Supreme Court's decision to authorize the negotiation of agency fees, the Chief Justice has determined to use the procedures of the Public Employment Relations Commission (PERC) Appeal Board for considering petitions of appeal of judicial employees who are not members of the employee organization that represents the employees' collective negotiations unit concerning the amount of the representation fee in lieu of dues paid by the non-member employees. PERC has agreed to review the Judiciary's representation fee cases in accordance with the rules that it has established for hearing such cases. These rules may be found at *N.J.A.C. 1:20-1.1, et. seq.*, and *N.J.A.C. 19:17-1.1, et. seq.*
