BUDGET DIRECTIVE ON TRIAL COURT FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY

Issued by: June 28, 1983
Chief Justice Robert N. Wilentz

Budget Presentation and Negotiation: The Trial Court Administrator may represent the Assignment Judge at all budget presentations to and in negotiations with the county authorities as well as at other public meetings. Where the Assignment Judge deems it appropriate, the head of a major organizational or functional unit may participate with the Trial Court Administrator in budget negotiations or presentations. Any amendments or supplements to the judicial budget after its initial submission to the county shall be made only by the Assignment Judge.

EDITOR'S NOTE

Only that part (section 8) of the original directive that retains any possible validity has been included in this compilation. With the advent of state funding of the court system, the bulk of the directive became obsolete.
